### **St George's Market**

As part of the Contemporary Crafts course students must complete investigations into the work and professional practices of craft makers/designers/artists. This makes up a large part of component one of the course which is worth 60% of their final mark.

To help students research local craft people I have organised a trip to St George's Market in Belfast on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> March. Students will have the opportunity to speak to people from many different trades, they will be filling in questionnaires and photographing their work which will make up a crucial part of their learning file.

As a reward for their hard work last term we will be going to 'We are Vertigo' after lunch. Most students have been to the trampoline park previously, so it is recommended that they bring their red 'bounce socks'. If you do not have a pair of bounce socks they can be purchased at the trampoline park for £2.

The total cost of the trip will be £15. This includes the transport and entrance into 'We are Vertigo'. We will be collected by Coach from Blackwater Integrated College at 9am sharp and will be back in school for 2.30pm. Students should bring money to buy their lunch or they can bring a packed lunch.
