Essential Skills Literacy and Communication qualification

From September 2018 the Essential Skills Literacy and Communication qualification will follow the OCN specification. This will simply replace the old course which has been withdrawn by CCEA. The change will not affect the course discussed at your child's option choices interview or their final qualifications.

To support and guide individual students to reach their full potential, and gain the best possible result, Essential Skills classes will be arranged differently this year. There will be one composite Entry Level class and one composite Level 1&2 class.

Students will be placed into the class which best supports them and suits their needs, rather than by year group.

We feel that this approach will be of huge benefit to the pupils as they will be in a supportive, specialised environment which focuses on their individual progression through each level of the qualification.
