Drum/Guitar/Voice/Piano Lessons

Instrumental lessons will soon resume in the Music Department. We have previously been able to offer voice, piano, drum and guitar tuition, where students can work towards music examinations or learn for pleasure. If your child is interested in learning to play any other instrument, write it in the space provided below. Lessons last for 30 minutes and can be booked as **one-to-one time or shared**, where possible, with one other student.

In bringing tutors into our College, we are guaranteeing them a year's work. If your child wished to cease having lessons, you must notify the music department, in writing, giving **three calendar months notice**.

Fees **must be paid at the beginning of each term**, usually for a session of ten lessons. In the event of student absence due to illness, lessons will be charged at the normal rate. If a student knows that he/she will be absent (e.g. college trip), I should be informed well in advance. Where possible, I will try to provide a new lesson time. Missed lessons will be charged at the full rate.

The fees applicable to this academic year (2017/18) are as follows: -

- **Term 1:** 10 weeks at £13.00 for 1/2 hour (or £6.50 for 1/2 hour if shared) = £130.00 (or £65 if shared).
- **Term 2:** 10 weeks at £13.00 for 1/2 hour (or £6.50 for 1/2 hour if shared) = £130.00 (or £65 if shared).
- **Term 3:** 10 weeks at £13.00 for 1/2 hour (or £6.50 for 1/2 hour if shared) = £130.00 (or £65 if shared).
