Spending just 10 minutes a day reading and sharing stories with young people can make a crucial difference to their outcome and it is fun for all involved.

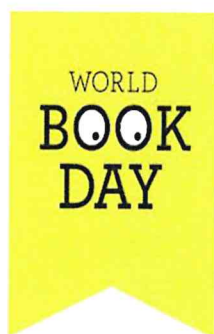
➤ **£1 Book Tokens**
