Careers

All year 12 students should have had a Careers Guidance Interview in school before the half term break. Following the interview, the Careers Advisor will send each student an email, outlining her post-16 recommendations for Further Education. Please ask your son/daughter to open the email with you and read over the recommendations to ensure that you are all happy with what has been suggested.

Over the coming weeks, we will be completing applications for courses in school but you can support them to do this at home, if you are comfortable with that. If you have any queries, let me know. Students can apply for up to 5 courses with SERC and Belfast Met. Those who are considering Sixth Form Colleges should make contact with them to enquire about their admissions procedure.

Next week is National Apprenticeship week (7th – 11th February). There are so many opportunities available for students who choose this route and they get paid on the job. Please search www.nidirect/Apprenticeships for more detailed information. There is also a room on Google Classroom for year 12s (Year 12 career Pathways) where I have uploaded information about Apprenticeships and guidance relevant to their future planning. Again, please ask your son/daughter to open the room with you to ensure that they do not miss any opportunities.
