Important Diary Dates

I would like to update you with some information for the remainder of this term and provide key dates for your attention. The weeks between now and the Christmas break are busy with several events taking place such as examinations and parent consultation meetings.

Some Year 11 and Year 12 students will sit GCSE module examinations between 21 November and 1 December, and it is vital that they undertake revision at home to supplement the preparation work being done in school, to help them achieve their best possible results.

For students in Years 8 – 11 Christmas examinations (Assessment 2) give an opportunity to monitor students' progress in the first term: students in all years should revise at home for these examinations. Class teachers will give guidance about how to revise and the topics they should know for the assessments.
