SIMS Parent App

I am writing to emphasise the importance of ensuring that you are signed up to the **SIMS Parent App**.

Firstly, we would like to apologise for the repeated messages regarding this matter. However, **there are still a significant number of parents who have not yet signed up to the SIMS Parent App and Parent Pay**, and it is essential that this is addressed as a matter of urgency. We would like all parents registered **before school reports are distributed in mid-June and to enable payments from September 2026**.

The SIMS Parent App provides an essential link between home and school. It allows you to access important information about your child's progress, including **school reports**, attendance, and key updates relating to their education. It is a vital tool in helping you stay fully informed and engaged with your child's school life.

In addition, **all school communications will be issued through the SIMS Parent App going forward**. It is therefore essential that every parent is registered and actively using the system to ensure you do not miss any important information or updates.

The app is also used to support our **Parent Pay system**. This means that **all payments** for school-related items—such as trips, activities, and Chromebook contributions—will be made through this platform. Moving to this system will help streamline payments and ensure greater efficiency and security. Without access, there is a risk that students may miss out on valuable opportunities.

If for any reason you are unable to access or use the SIMS Parent App, we ask that you **contact the school office as soon as possible** so that alternative arrangements can be discussed.
